The Food Act 2006 commences on 1 July 2006.

This removes the dual system of requiring a licence and registration to operate a food business

Temporary food businesses operated by a non profit organisation (where meals are served on less than twelve occasions) are required to comply with the Act but do not require a licence to operate.

Renewal application fees include annual inspections dependant on risk classification.

Risk classification is calculated using the Priority Classification System for Food Businesses as developed by Australian New Zealand Food Authority (ANZFA).
