About this mission

There is significant activity in the PNG resources sector - both mining and petroleum. This is evidenced in the mining sector through both exploration programs and mine expansion plans, and in the petroleum sector through the proposed USD\$10 billion plus PNG LNG Project. This activity offers new opportunities for Australian suppliers to win potential new export business.

To capitalise on these opportunities Austrade is coordinating the 2009 PNG Resources Mission. The Mission will be held in parallel with the PNG Chamber of Mines and Petroleum's 2009 Seminar. Held every two years, the Seminar will provide separate mining and petroleum sessions with updates from key industry leaders. Austrade will facilitate one-on-one meetings with key delegates and customers during the Seminar.

Market insights

- Mining activity in PNG remains buoyant due to continued expansion in top tier mines e.g. plans to increase production at Lihir Gold to more than one million ounces from 2012.
- New mining projects such as Harmony, Ramu Nickel Mine, Simberi and Sinivit are in various stages of development.
- The proposed USD\$10 billion plus PNG LNG Project will potentially provide significant supply opportunities in the initial construction phase as well as during the life of the project.
- Given Australia's proximity to PNG, and its reputation as having international standard suppliers, Australian supply inputs are expected to grow.
